Application Corrections

Unapplied payments error [114838]

We resolved issues that were causing errors when trying to apply multiple payments to invoices.

Can't add new customer [114168]

The customer wizard was allowing a site name longer than 50 characters, which was causing an error. We have limited this to a maximum of 50 characters.

Applied credits showing with incorrect date/time stamps [115796]

We resolved this issue by hiding the time stamp that was shown with the date and by hiding the default date in instances where the default was a null value.

Auto apply of unapplied payments creates an error applying payments to multiple invoices (same as case 114838) [116706]

There was an error auto applying payments to invoices. We resolved this by detaching entities about applying each payment.

Dates off by day on P&L report [117097]

The P&L Report was not showing the dates entered by users. We corrected this by accepting the dates in the user's time zone and converting to UTC time.

NULL WorkOrderID in GL entry table preventing creation of income statement via data warehouse [117163]

When a work order was completed and an invoice generated, the GL entry for the invoice was not recording the work order number. The work order ID in the GL entry was NULL. We corrected this so Managely sets the work order ID for the invoice GL entry and the entry details and for the issue/return GL entry and entry details.

RMRs not calculating tax on master RMR charges [117439]

Managely is now calculating tax on master RMR charges.
